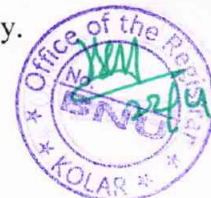

Instructions:

1. The Guidelines related to Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of **COVID-19** Pandemic Issued by UGC, Ministry of Human Resources Department., GOI vide their **D.O.No.F1- 1/2020(Secy), Dated: 29th April, 2020** and Revised UGC Guidelines issued on **6th July, 2020** Shall Be noted. The Standard Operating Procedure (Sop) formulated by UGC and safety measures Prescribed by **MOHA, GOI and MOHFW, GOI** shall be followed. All precautions are to be taken for the welfare of Students accordingly.
2. Every institute should develop virtual classroom and video conferencing facility and all Teaching staff should be trained with the use of the technology.

Note:

1. The Teachers shall attend the Examination works including valuation works as per the Instruction of Registrar (Eva)/ Principals/ Chairman BOE/ Custodians of Examination without fail.
2. The Calendar of Events regarding last working day for II, IV & VIth sem IA marks uploading, examination schedule etc will be notified separately.



General Guidelines:

1. The Norms / conditions mentioned in the Affiliation Order of the respective Colleges shall be adhered.
2. The Colleges shall submit the applications for issue of Eligibility certificate in respect of Foreign Nationals before 30.01.2021. The applications received after this date will not be considered.
3. The last date for obtaining permission from University for admission to III/V&VII semester on transfer from other Colleges / Universities and Re-admission to III/V&VII semester before **30.01.2021**
4. The Guidelines for completion of degree circulated vide circular No: Aca-I/UGC-Guidelines/Span Period/2017-18 dated: 13.07.2017 may be displayed on the College Notice Board.
5. Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System (Semester Scheme) in the Undergraduate and Integrated Masters Degree Programmes in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce shall be followed for the academic year 2020-21.
6. Principals shall forward the representations of the Students seeking permission for transfer admission along with No Due Certificate, No Objection Certificate, Migration Certificate and Photo copies of previous semester marks cards to the University within the notified dates.
7. Principals are requested to make admissions strictly in accordance with the Eligibility criteria and also as per the sanction intake for each course and within the last dates by observing the rule related to attendance.
8. The Principals should consider the marks cards of the qualifying exams of the recognized Boards only. The list of recognized Boards is also available in the University Website: i.e., www.bnu.ac.in. Any Marks card other than notified shall not be considered.
9. The Students who have passed 2nd Year PUC Examination from Karnataka Pre-University Board, Government of Karnataka are eligible for admissions to Under-Graduate Degree Courses.
10. The Students who have passed (10+2) Examination conducted by recognized National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) is eligible subject to recognition by Govt. for admissions to Under-Graduate Courses with the approval of the University.
11. Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System – CBCS (Semester Scheme) in the Under-Graduate Courses in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce shall be followed.
12. Principals are requested to allot the invigilation work to the Teaching of major subjects such as Commerce, Management, English, Mathematics, Economics, etc., in the beginning of the Theory examination and relieve them immediately for evaluation work.
13. Principals are further requested to compulsorily collect the evaluation attendance certificate from all the Teachers who attended evaluation work in different subjects and produce them before the Local Inquiry Committee (LIC) for verification at the time of the visit.
14. During vacation, it is mandatory for Teachers to undertake all Examination work such as theory Practical and other examination related works assigned by the University. Otherwise disciplinary action will be initiated for dereliction of duty, University,

- Government and Aided College Teachers and in case of Un-aided Colleges attending to the examination works are one of the essential conditions to continue Affiliation.
15. Submission of any required documents after the date of approval will not be considered for admission approval.
 16. Where ever Bio-Metric attendance is implemented, The Principals are requested to take permission from the Higher Authorities to waive the requirement of attendance of the Teachers on the days of the examination related work in the University especially during the evaluation of answer books.
 17. The Colleges have to collect and remit the fee as prescribed by the University is also available (Copy enclosed) see Annexure – A,B,C in the website: www.bnu.ac.in
 18. The Principals are requested to adhere to the above schedule of Calendar of Events and strictly follow the Rules and Regulations of University and State Government.
 19. No Admissions will be allowed after last date.
 20. The Principals/ BOE of the concerned subject are required to upload the I A marks, practical examination marks etc. within the prescribed date.
 21. Late submission will not be entertained and provision of penal fees and other legal provisions will be initiated to the concerned if any details in this matter.
